Dear Parents.

I hope you have had a lovely time over the summer and I am sure you are now ready to start the new school year. I am looking forward to getting to know all children in Oak class and working together so that we have a very exciting and productive year.

The children will continue to receive a broad and balanced curriculum, including weekly PE, science, humanities, art and music lessons. We have reviewed our curriculum to take into consideration the learning children have missed and adjusted our plans so that it enables the children to repeat aspects they may need to, but also supports rapid progress.

Reading

Your child will choose reading books to bring home every Monday and will need to take responsibility to record any comments in their home learning diary. When they have signed their reading records to indicate they have finished reading the book, they can change them. Children should bring their home learning diary and reading book into school daily but will only be checked by an adult on a Monday.

Spellings

Spellings will be sent home every Monday and tested on Friday. Children will keep a copy of the spellings in their home learning diary and they can use the home learning diary to practise writing them.

Homework

In addition to reading and spellings the children must also practise maths skills at least 5 times per week. More information about this can be found in your child's home learning diary. If you would like to complete any extra homework there are some ideas linked to our current topic that can be found attached to the curriculum letter. This is not a requirement but an opportunity for those children who wish to do more.

General Reminders

- The children start school at 8.50am. We will start each morning with the daily mile so your child will
 need trainers to change into when they arrive at school.
- The children will be doing **PE** every **Monday** and **Thursday**. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on these days.
- Forest school is every Friday. Your child will need a pair of wellies that can be left at school during term time.
- Water bottles should be brought into school every day. Please make sure your child's name is written clearly on their water bottle.
