Support for disadvantaged children

The government have published their offer for increasing data on mobile devices to support disadvantaged children. This includes children who are eligible for free school meals (not including those in reception, Y1 and Y2 who have universal free school meals). It states that schools can request mobile data increases for children and young people who:

- do not have fixed broadband at home
- cannot afford additional data for their devices
- are experiencing disruption to their face-to-face education
