How did the Romans change Britain?



Questions we'll be asking...

- When and how did the Romans conquer Britain?
- How did the Roman empire spread?
- What were the different roles in Roman society?
- Where were Roman roads built and how were they made?
- How did the Roman empire effect different people?
- What was Hadrian wall and why was it built?
- What were the Romans religious beliefs?
- What were Roman baths like?

In Science we will be learning to:

Living things and their habitats: The children will explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. They will find out about, describe and compare the animals that are found in our local area. Animals including humans: The children construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey in our local area.

In RE we will be learning to:

The children will learn how Christians show their beliefs about God the Trinity in worship and that Christians believe God is Trinity. The children will explore how Advent and Christmas traditions are celebrated across the world.

In PSHE we will be learning to:

The children will learn about respecting similarities and differences between people and what they have in common with others. They will learn about stereotypes and how they are not always accurate, and can negatively influence behaviours and attitudes towards others and how to challenge stereotypes and assumptions about others. They children will learn how people make decisions about spending and saving money and what influences them. They will identify how to keep track of money so people know how much they have to spend or save.

In French we will be learning to:

The children will be learning how to present themselves and foods including vegetables. They will look at how Christmas is celebrated in France.



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In History we will be learning to:

In history the children will look at how people lived including: daily life, leisure, buildings, language, religion, gods, the army. They will learn that Rome is in Italy and that the Roman empire included many countries. They will learn about significant people in Roman time. In geography they will learn the features of Roman roads and describe how they have shaped our road system today.

In Computing we will be learning to:

Coding: They will look at the stages of the design, code, test, debug coding process. They will understand and use variables in 2Code and use flowcharts for design of algorithms including selection. Online safety: They will understand how to protect themselves from online identity theft and that information put online leaves a digital footprint or trail and that this can aid identity theft.

In Music we will be learning about :

Livin' on a Prayer: The children will learn songs and perform compositions within the song with music style of Rock. Classroom Jazz 1: Learning improvisation learnt in previous units

In Art & DT we will be learning to:

In art the children will explore why Roman mosaics are preserved and visited today. In DT they will look at designing, making and evaluating a healthy pizza with ingredients from Italy (link to geography – Italian food)

In PE we will be learning to :

The children will be learning football and tag rugby skills.
