## FOT update

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### Becoming a School Governor

Dear Parents,

You may remember when we first federated that we sent out some information about school governance. Being a governor is a voluntary role. If you feel you don't have time for volunteering, being a governor might be easier than you think. Whilst we do have meetings, they are always agreed well in advance, so you can plan for these. The majority of the work you can decide when you do this, by visiting the school and meeting with teachers. This is part of our 'monitoring' role.
