In Science we will be learning to:

States of matter: The children will learn how the water cycle works. They will identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature. Animals including humans: The children will name the main body parts associated with the digestive system, mouth, tongue, teeth, oesophagus, stomach, and small and large intestine, and describe and understand their special function.

In RE we will be learning to:

The children will explore when Jesus left, the impact of the Pentecost. They will learn about the Holy Spirit and how the Holy Spirit is celebrated at Pentecost. The children will learn the importance of equality to the Sikh community and ways in which equality is practised in the Sikh community.

In PSHE we will be learning to:

The children will learn how laws surrounding the use of drugs exist to protect them and others. They will learn how organisations help people to stop smoking and the support available to help people if they have concerns about any drug use. They will learn how to ask for help from a trusted adult if they have any worries or concerns about drugs. The children will learn that there is a broad range of different jobs and people often have more than one during their careers and over their lifetime and *about the skills, attributes, qualifications and training needed for different jobs

In French we will be learning to:

The children will be learn about pets and animals. They will be learn the days of the weeks and months. The children will learn about Bastile day.



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In Topic we will be learning to:

In history the children will order history events in a timeline. They will understand why people migrated from the Caribbean to England in 1948. The children will identify some of the challenges faced by the people of the Caribbean as they arrived and tried to settle in Britain. They will name historical figures from the Windrush generation and their contributions to Britain. The children will understand how the Windrush migration changed Britain for the better.

In Computing we will be learning to:

Logo: They will learn the structure of the coding language of Logo and input simple instructions in Logo.
